



Install the Fixture



- Determine the wanted height or look of the fixture with the provided stems, and hang straight/loop and link and assemble them by screwing them together. All the parts may be used alone or used in combination.
- 2 Feed the fixture wires through the stems and screw to the fixture tightly.
- 3 Screw the collar nut down until it is loose on the stem, then slide the canopy onto the stem.
- 4 Screw the shorter end of the threaded nipple tightly onto the mounting plate.
- 5 Feed the fixture wires through the mounting plate/nipple assembly and screw it tightly onto the screw collar.
- 6 Align the mounting plate to the electrical box and secure the fixture tightly with two mounting plate screws.
- Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 8 Connect the white fixture wire (square and rigid tracer) to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 2 Connect the black fixture wire (round and smooth tracer) to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Neatly place all the wires into the electrical box, place the canopy onto the ceiling, and secure it in place by screwing the collar nut tightly onto the screw collar.
- II Screw the threaded rod into the bottom of the fixture, then slide the cap onto the threaded rod and secure the cap with the finial.
- Screw the lamp in to the socket. Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage information.
