



INSTRUCTIONS

I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Carefully unbox and examine all the items included in the packaging of the fixture.
- 2. Locate the mounting plate with screw collar and secure it to the junction box using the mounting screws.
- 3. Determine the desired height of the fixture and complete the stem assembly accordingly by screwing the stems together.
- 4. Feed the fixture wires through the stem assembly, collar nut, canopy, and half ball assembly.
- 5. Secure the stem assembly on top of the fixture.
- 6. Lift the fixture stem and slide the half ball assembly onto the screw collar portion of the mounting plate.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) Hot fixture wire (black) to hot power line wire
 - b) Neutral fixture wire (white) to neutral power line wire
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting plate into the junction box.

III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Place the canopy onto the mounting plate with screw collar and secure it in place by screwing the collar nut tightly onto it.
- 2. Install the shade over the shade bracket and secure it with the shade screws and cap nuts.
- 3. Install the bulb to finish. Refer to label on socket for max wattage information.
